INDIA PALE ALE

HALF PINTS LITTLE SCRAPPER IPA (6.0%) **341ML \$6.50**
 Canada. Former Bushwacker brewer David Rudge opened his own microbrewery in Winnipeg a few years ago. This is one of his brewery's bitter offerings.

DOG FISH HEAD 60 MINUTE IPA (6.0%) **355ML \$7.50**
 USA. A powerful east coast IPA with plenty of citrusy hop character. The session beer for hopheads.

DOG FISH HEAD 90 MINUTE IMPERIAL IPA (9.0%) **355ML \$8.95**
 USA. A big beer with a great malt backbone that stands up to the extreme hopping rate. A bitter treat indeed!

GREEN FLASH WEST COAST IPA (7.3%) **355ML \$7.50**
 USA. An extravagantly hopped west coast-style IPA from California. A menagerie of hops contribute grapefruit zest, hop pungency, pine and citrus notes with floral aroma. Hop complexity at its finest.

FLANDERS RED ALE

RODENBACH GRAND CRU (6.5%) **330ML \$7.95**
 Belgium. The classic example of this style. Ages for up to two years in huge oak barrels which contain the special bacteria necessary to pleasantly "sour" the beer. Very wine-like.

DUCHESS DE BOURGOGNE (6.2%) **330ML \$8.95**
 Belgium. Another "Burgundy of Belgium". Deep red colour, soft sweet malt flavours with a gently sour balsamic bite. One of the more interesting beers you'll ever drink.

APPLE CIDER

STRONGBOW (5.3%) **500ML \$7.95**
 England. Dry and crisp. The benchmark apple cider against which all others are measured.

MAGNER'S (4.5%) **500ML \$9.25**
 Ireland. This specially imported cider pours a deep gold with a slightly sweeter taste.

ROCK CREEK (5.5%) **355ML \$5.95**
 Canada. From Calgary's Big Rock Brewery. Made with Okanagan and European apples.

WHEAT/WIT

ERDINGER WEISSBIER (5.3%) **500ML \$7.50**
 Germany. A hazy blond unfiltered Bavarian beer of great complexity brewed with wheat and barley. Displays the classic characters associated with this style: banana, clove, spice, bubblegum and apple.

HOEGAARDEN WIT (5.0%) **330ML \$6.95**
 Belgium. A classic! Moderately zesty citrus orange fruitiness with a touch of coriander.

DIEU DU CIEL ROSEE D'HIBISCUS (5.0%) **341ML \$7.95**
 Canada. Pink hibiscus tropical flowers are added to this wheat beer contributing a pleasant aroma and quenching character.

SPECIALTY AND STRONG

DUCHY ORIGINAL ORGANIC ALE (5.0%) **500ML \$8.95**
 England. A premium bitter featuring caramel flavours from a rare breed of organic barley called Plumage Archer and the signature orange nuances of the organic First Gold hop.

INNIS & GUNN RUM CASK OAK AGED BEER (7.4%) **330ML \$8.95**
 Scotland. Aged in American oak and selected navy rum barrels for 107 days. Mellow oak, malt and fruit notes balanced by a lively spiciness.

DIEU DU CIEL ROUTE DES EPICES (5.0%) **341ML \$7.50**
 Canada. From the "God in Heaven" brewery in Montreal. "Spice Route" is a rye beer brewed with the addition of peppercorns. Some like it hot!

TIN WHISTLE KILLER BEE DARK HONEY ALE (6.0%) **650ML \$10.95**
 Canada. A flavour explosion of chocolate malted barley. Four specialty honeys and a hint of spice contribute to a sweetish finish. Yummy!

KWAK (8.0%) **330ML \$7.95**
 Belgium. This Belgian strong ale pours a rich amber colour and has a slightly sweet and spicy character. Reminds one of a caramelized banana.

THOMAS HARDY'S VINTAGE ALE (11.7%) **275ML \$10.95**
 England. The beer enthusiast's equivalent of a rare cognac. Will mature like fine wine for decades. Very scarce. Many layers of rich, thick complex malt flavours. Very port-like. Luscious and refined.

LA MESSAGERE (4.7%) **341ML \$6.50**
 Canada. North America's first gluten free beer. A very light blond ale brewed with rice and buckwheat.

GULDEN DRAAK EXTRA (10.5%) **330ML \$8.95**
 Belgium. A Belgian dark strong ale. Very rich, complex, strong yet smooth. Dangerous!

STOUT

GUINNESS (4.1%) **HALFPINT \$4.95** **PINT \$7.25**
Ireland. Dry roasty malt character, a tiny bit of sour, firm bitterness, a signature creamy head, light alcohol.

HALF PINTS STIR STICK STOUT (5.6%) **341ML** **\$6.50**
Canada. Lots of roasted barley with a generous addition of freshly roasted Ethiopian Yirga Cheffe coffee.

DIEU DU CIEL PECHE MORTEL (9.5%) **341ML** **\$7.95**
Canada. An imperial coffee stout. Strong, rich and very complex. A seamless marriage of coffee and ale. Exceptional.

YOUNG'S DOUBLE CHOCOLATE STOUT (5.2%) **500ML** **\$9.50**
England. One of the best chocolate stouts we've found. Chocolate malt and real dark chocolate create a wonderful aroma and flavour. Not overly sweet.

BROOKLYN BREWING BLACK CHOCOLATE STOUT . (10.6%) **355ML** **\$7.95**
USA. This imperial stout achieves a luscious and deep chocolate flavour by using a blend of specially roasted malts. Very rich. Will age nicely for years.



BELGIAN LAMBIC/FRUIT LAMBIC

ST. LOUISE GUEUZE (4.5%) **375ML** **\$9.95**
Belgium. A blend of young and aged Belgian wheat (wit) beer is fermented with wild yeasts producing very mellow and balanced flavours of tart and sweet with earthiness.

LINDEMANS FRAMBOISE (4.0%) **355ML** **\$10.95**
Belgium. The preferred fruit to blend with a lambic. Tart yet sweet intense fresh raspberry flavour. Like raspberry champagne.

LINDEMANS PECHERESSE (4.0%) **355ML** **\$10.95**
Belgium. Slightly tart yet smooth and sweet. Natural tasting peach undertones blend beautifully with the light wheat beer. Divine.



LIGHT LAGERS

CORONA (4.6%) **330ML** **\$5.95**
Mexico. Light, refreshing, quenching. With a wedge of lime how could it not be?

HACKER PSCHORR EDEHELL (5.5%) **500ML** **\$7.95**
Germany. "Edehell" means "noble light". A fine Bavarian Munich Helles style lager from one of the country's oldest breweries.

HEINEKEN (5.0%) **330ML** **\$5.95**
Holland. Sold in over 170 countries. Global brand domination.

STELLA ARTOIS (5.2%) **500ML** **\$7.50**
Belgium. We offer this soft, delicate lager in tins which provide superior protection from harmful sunlight compared to the more readily available green bottles.

TRAPPIST/ABBEY BELGIAN ALES

AFFLIGEM BLOND (7.0%) **330ML** **\$6.95**
Belgium. A classic blond Belgian ale. Mildly spicy with a medium body. Good malt and hop balance.

LEFFE BRUNE (6.5%) **330ML** **\$7.95**
Belgium. A traditional full bodied abbey dubbel. Pours a dark brown with flavours of roasted malts and caramel bitter sweetness. Medium-light mouthfeel. Fruit and clove aromas.

TRIPLE KARMELIET (8.0%) **330ML** **\$8.95**
Belgium. Made with three types of grains (wheat, oats and barley) and refermented in the bottle. Blond, robust and smooth. Delightful.

WESTMALLE TRIPLE (9.2%) **330ML** **\$8.95**
Belgium. Golden yellow colour. A complex beer with fruity esters and gentle hop aromas. Strong, dry and spicy. The mother of all tripels!

ROCHFORT 8 (9.2%) **330ML** **\$8.95**
Belgium. Pours a deep brown with sweet figs, raisins, roasted malts and alcohol flavours. Very rich, creamy and complex.

ROCHFORT 10 (11.3%) **330ML** **\$9.50**
Belgium. The top product from one of the best Trappist breweries in the world. Incredibly rich flavours of plums, raisins, black currants, caramel with lingering spices. A truly great beer!

FRUIT BEERS

FRULI (4.1%) **250ML** **\$6.95**
Belgium. This witbier has a very pronounced yet natural fruit flavour. Strawberry jam in a glass.

FLORIS NINKEBERRY (3.0%) **330ML** **\$7.95**
Belgium. Mango, apricot, peach and passion fruit. 'Tis a fruit bomb!

TIN WHISTLE CHERRY CHOCOLATE PORTER (5.5%) **650ML** **\$10.95**
Canada. This limited release brew features semi-sweet dark chocolate aroma and flavour with subtle cherry notes in the finish. Black forest cake.

BOCK

CELEBRATOR DOPPELBOCK (6.7%) **330ML** **\$8.95**
Germany. One of the most famous examples of this beer style. A dark rich elixir with a complex fruitiness of roasted malt and hops. Semi-dry, smoky finish. Excellent.

ROGUE DEAD GUY ALE (6.6%) **355ML** **\$7.95**
USA. First brewed in the early 1990s as a celebration of the Mayan day of the dead. Rogue claims this is a German-style Maibock or Heller Bock. Yet it reminds us of a Scottish Wee Heavy. Try the beer that defies description.
